

A major supply of water comes from Bucal Pumping Station which serves the residents of Calamba City proper. It is interconnected to different pumping stations such as, Crossing Pumping Station, Villa de Calamba, Marcville Subd. and Landmark Subd. in Brgy. Parian, Lawa and Real Pumping Station.



Apparently, the barangays far from the main service area have separate water supply. There are eight pumping stations in Kapayapaan Village located in Canlubang, Calamba City namely MCDC I and II, Manfil, Asiacon I and II, Majada-In Housing, Sitio Tibagan and Siranglupa. Others are located in Villa La Prinza, Brgy. Barandal, Punta, Bunggo, Palo Alto Kanluran and Maresco Subd. in Palo Alto, Glenwood in Brgy. Turbina and Tulo, Saimsim, Makiling, Maunong, Homeland Subd in Brgy. Tulo, Laguna Hills in Brgy. Bucal, San Cristobal Garden Homes in Brgy. San Cristobal, Villa Palao Banlic, Aztec and La Consolacion in Brgy. Looc.

THE JOURNEY IS STILL FAR FROM FINISH...



Looking closely at its history, it is inspiring to know how Calamba Water District transcended all the bumps and hurdles of its past and achieved the development that its present status reveals.

Reminiscing its inception, the water supply system in Calamba, established as early as 1926, was managed by the Municipal Government through the then called Calamba Water District System. Blessed with its abundance, the sole source of water that supplied the whole town was Tigbe Spring. However, during that stint of time, it was the National Water Sewerage Authority (NAWASA) that had authority and duly responsible in the operation and management of all water utilities in the country.

Come 1964, the responsibility over the water system was then transferred to the Municipal Government. It was also during this time that another water source was utilized, the Bucal Spring with approximately 16.4 kilometer of pipelines and 380 cubic meter concrete reservoir.

The creation of The Provincial Water Utilities Act of 1973 also known as the Presidential Decree No. 198 (PD 198) paved the way for the numerous births of various local water districts in the country. This was crafted on the National Government viewpoint on the policy which Filipinos could hold on to and shall vouch for a guaranteed access to safe, potable, adequate supply of water 24 hours a day.

On August 07, 1974, the Sangguniang Bayan of Calamba, headed by then Mayor Taciano Rizal, passed the Municipal Board Resolution No. 82 Series of 1974 in pursuant to P.D. 198 as amended. Said Resolution gave rise to the organization of the CALAMBA WATER DISTRICT (CWD) and mandated the transfer to its jurisdiction and ownership of all existing water facilities within the geographic borders of Calamba Municipality.

After a couple of years of its operation, CWD had consummated the minimum requirements of the Local Water Utilities Administration thus brought about the award of Conditional Certificate of Conformance No. 29 granted on the 4th of September 1976. This Certificate became the key for CWD to the rights and privileges authorized under PD 198. This then pronounced the official day of Calamba Water District in carrying out its mission, which at that time, provided service to a total of 1,100 active service connections.

Marching towards its vision since then, growth and expansion is invincible and gradually came into view. Such has been apparent in the structure of its edifice, the four-storey "Dream Building" (as once named by the pioneering employees), that has become the emblem of its progress. At present, this serves as a harbor where 282 personnel are housed, sharing the same core values and working hand in hand towards one mission and vision. It is also the central venue for serving the growing number of concessionaires, which up to the end of 2010 was totalled to an aggregate number of 40,151 service connections. This current record covers almost 50% of the total population of Calamba City, thus, it can be derived that CWD has broad opportunity to optimize its operation until all areas under its jurisdiction is waterlogged.

On the average, an increment of more than one thousand connections is being added each year since 1976. Proportionately, such growth exigently yielded to the development and expansion of facilities, use of latest technologies and modern equipment, as well as accreditation from government agencies which are essential in carrying out good quality service. In particular, among others are additional water facilities and pump stations in different communities, well-structured water distribution system, modern technologies used in monitoring water production and distribution, water treatment facilities, reservoir, fire hydrants, DOH Accredited Laboratory, Warehouse as well as motorcycles and service vehicles.

These advances then served as a ladder for the CWD to reach the category of Very Large Water District. And in 2008, all the finest hard work of its people was paid off as the progress was recognized by the Philippine Association of Water Districts, placing the CWD as BEST WATER DISTRICT NOMINEE for Very Large Water District Category and Nominee for Top Water District Performer Award 2008 during the 3rd SEAWUN Convention.

35 years had passed, and tracking down the path by which the District had been through is awe-inspiring and should motivate its entire staff, from the Board of Directors down to the Management, and rank and file, to strive more to preserve the CWD's integrity and keep up its progress. It has truly gone a long way; however, considering the broad potentials, the journey is still far from finish. We're not through yet, so press on CWD!
